Graduate profile	Graduates of the Faculty of Medicine receive a diploma and the professional title of a doctor. After graduation, they take the Medical Final Examination and, upon passing it, they obtain the right to practice medicine, which entitles them to work in health care institutions, R&D and academic centres as well as clinics at medical universities. Completion of the studies enables the students to improve their qualifications, knowledge and skills within medical specialisations and supplementary and further training courses in various medical fields, as well as to continue their education in third-level (doctoral) studies.
