Admission to the Faculty of Medicine with English as the language of instruction is open to candidates with a number of points (see above) within the limit of places allocated for the 2024/2025 recruitment process.

Candidates applying to study Medicine with English as the language of instruction are required to submit a duly certified document to confirm their command of English (at least **B2** level), or their result of the written English exam for the Secondary School Leaving Certificate at Advanced Level (at least **80%**), or their grade in English (at least "**Good**").

Candidates with the "old type" Secondary School Leaving Certificate are required to have obtained "Good" (at least) in the Certificate or a document confirming that they have graduated from a secondary school or a higher education institution (in Poland or abroad) where English was the language of instruction.

Each new student enrolled **to the Faculty of Medicine** with English as the language of instruction will attend a mandatory on-line prep course (100 hours) covering Biology, Biochemistry and Biophysics using the Pearson platform.
