1. What perspective is?

Photorealism is a style of art that attempts to achieve the same level of detail as a photography.

4. Who is the best Photorealism artist?

The most popular Photorealist artists include: Chuck Close, Ralph Goings and Richard Estes.

5. Who is Leonardo Da Vinci?

I also said some kind of informatoin about Leonardo Da Vinci. He was a master of anatomy, drawings and art in general. He is known as renaissance humanist ideal. He became known for his notebooks, in which he made drawings of human body, things and notes.
