

**Principles of training in occupational safety and health
(OSH) and the deadlines for their implementation**

I. UR students

1. The student is informed of the obligation to participate in OSH training, the date and manner of its implementation through the UR website or the Virtual University system.
2. OSH training is made available on the e-learning platform of the University of Rzeszow at: *elearning.ur.edu.pl*, within the deadline: October 25 - November 15 of each academic year.
3. The dean's office of the college - by October 15 of the given academic year - shall apply to the University Center for Distance Learning to make available to students of the given field of study the OSH training and the final assessment test. To this end, it shall forward to the University's Distance Learning Center, for the attention of the year supervisor:
 - 1) a complete list of the students of a particular course covered by the training, including album numbers and e-mail addresses;
 - 2) The name of the year supervisor and his/her email address.
4. Credit for OSH training is given by solving a test.
5. The condition for passing the test is to answer more than half of the questions correctly.
6. The results of the test are forwarded to the year supervisor, who enters in the Virtual University system the student's passing or failing of the OHS training. The date on which the student passes the OHS training is considered to be the date on which the student passes the test on the e-learning platform.
7. If a student fails to attend the OSH training on the first scheduled date or fails to pass the assessment test on that date, the year supervisor shall apply to the University's Distance Learning Center to make the health and safety training available on the second date, falling no later than the end of the teaching period scheduled in the winter semester.
8. Failure to pass the health and safety training in the 2nd term is grounds for denial of credit for the first term.
9. The supervisor of the year also enters into the WU system the credits for students referred to in § 9(8) of the Ordinance, no later than November 15 of the academic year.

II. UR doctoral students

To doctoral students beginning their training at the Doctoral School, the rules set forth for students shall apply accordingly, with the proviso that:

1. The request for OSH training and the screening test is directed by the secretary office of UR Doctoral School.
2. The test results are forwarded to the Director of the Doctoral School

III. Participants in postgraduate studies and other forms of education

To participants in a postgraduate program or other form of training, the rules set forth for students shall apply accordingly, with the proviso that:

1. The request for OSH training and a postgraduate test shall be directed by the head of the postgraduate program or other form of training;
2. The test results are forwarded to the head of the postgraduate program or other form of training.
