(Streszczenie pracy w języku angielskim)

National identity of Ukrainian students studying in south-eastern Poland

The subject of the scientific dissertation is the national identity of students from Ukraine studying in south-eastern Poland, which has been presented in a sociological and socio-historical perspective - as a dynamic, changing phenomenon, in a constructivist approach. The specificity of its formation is influenced by various elements, such as historical events, political conditions, cultural heritage, geographical location, religion, language, tradition, media, family or social groups.

In the case of young Ukrainians, the process of shaping national unity is still ongoing, and nowadays there is talk of a community or building a civil society that is "on the cusp" of geopolitical changes in the face of war. Just a year ago, the division into western and eastern Ukraine seemed to be permanent and historically conditioned. Now we are witnessing a rediscovery of the Ukrainian identity, especially of the young generation of Ukrainians, which is constantly evolving, changing both under the influence of external and internal factors. It is diverse, not only in terms of national awareness, but also cultural.

The work includes the analysis of existing materials and the results of own research.

The socio-historical history of the Ukrainian nation in the process of shaping the consciousness of the Ukrainian nation was presented. These are questions about the positive and negative features of the ethos of young people in the context of national identity, about the possibility of a universalist approach and thinking about national issues in relation to the past and the future.
