In this case, it includes material administrative law issues, especially those concerning development of historic immovable monuments for useful purposes in the aspect of public law. The seminar's purpose is to prepare PhD candidate for independent research work, i.e. by improvement of skills related to conducting research or holding discussions at scientific level (i.e. presenting knowledge on particular issue, presenting research results, asking the right questions, justifying theses). In the frame of seminars, PhD candidate will be provided with all the necessary support as regards preparing doctoral thesis, research papers or conference speeches.
