BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF COURSE (100-200 words)								
<p>The course will train the Doctoral student to working with sources covering the history of Polish archaeology</p> <p>1). Defining the subject of the doctoral dissertation – the spatial and temporal frames of research;</p> <p>2). Overview of sources for the history of the Polish People's Republic (PPR) and the history of Polish archaeology in this period (1944-1989), with special focus on Public Archives: State Archive of New Records, Polish Academy of Sciences [Warsaw] and Institute of Archaeology and Ethnography PAS [Warsaw], and private archives e.g. of K. Jaźdżewski [Museum in Łódź];</p> <p>3). Overview of sources for the 20th c. history of eastern Poland, including its cultural and academic development (academic archives [notably that of Maria Curie-Skłodowska University [Lublin], National Museum [Przemyśl – particularly the records related to activities of A. Żaki], District Museum [Rzeszów]]);</p> <p>4). Oral history as a source for the history of Polish archaeology;</p> <p>5). Censorship of academic research in PPR and its relevance in the study of Polish archaeology history;</p> <p>6). Critical reading of key texts concerning the history of Polish archaeology after World War II and the early history of the Polish People's Republic, with special focus on the financing of academic research by State authorities (nationalist legitimisation of Communist rule in Poland) and the contest between the Catholic Church and the Party during the celebrations of the Polish Millennium in 1996;</p> <p>6). Practical and logistical assistance offered to doctoral students in their individual research projects (especially material gathering trips inside Poland, interviewing researchers);</p> <p>Course content: closely related to the doctoral thesis of Edyta Kieboń (working title: In the shadow of the Millennium. Archaeological studies in Early Middle Ages in eastern Poland after World War II). Primarily the works of archaeologists and historians: A. Abramowicz, M. Kurkowska-Budzan, J. Lech, A. Mlynarczyk-Tomczyk, Z. Romek, R. Stobiecki, A. Szczerba, J. Szumski, M. Zaremba.</p>

COURSE CONTENT

Related to the writing of a doctoral thesis, working title: In the shadow of the Millennium. Archaeological studies in Early Middle Ages in eastern Poland after World War II.

These are divided into four groups:

- I. Developments in the Polish archaeology in the 20th century
 - a). A late start of medieval studies (the effect of Partitions of Poland)
 - b). Main focus on the study of archaeology in Great Poland (due to the activity of archaeologists from that region: Józef Kostrzewski, Witold Hensel)
 - c). Domination of ethical and historical issues in Polish archaeology

- d). Archaeology versus history
- II. Preconditions of the politics of academic research in Polish People's Republic
- Anti-German stance intended to lend legitimacy to the Polish United People's Party (PZPR)
 - Ethnic and religious minorities in Polish People's Republic
 - opportunities and limitations for international character of research in the Polish People's Republic
- III. The peripheries of the Polish People's Republic – between modernisation and stagnation
- Economic history of Polish People's Republic (failed) attempts to modernise eastern Poland
- IV. Millennial studies in eastern Poland. Researchers and research centres
