Within these principles, they also learn about the important role of vocal behaviour, appearance and environmental factors. It is also important to acquire the skills to prepare a multimedia presentation and a conference poster. The main goal is for the doctoral student to prepare a public speech by correlating all these skills using modern scientific language and multimedia.
