**3. Purposes of processing the data and legal basis**

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6(1) (e) and (f) of EU Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the European Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the flow of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)

- the performance of the public task of the university, consisting, in particular, in the dissemination of the achievements of science and culture during the conference [Art. 11(1) pt. 9 of the Act of 20 July 2018. Law on higher education and science].
- Legally justified interest pursued by the university or a third party through the use, including the dissemination of an image that constitutes only a detail of the whole and not the main motive of the photograph and/or recording; of a person commonly known in connection with the performance of public functions for information and promotional purposes (Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of 4.02.1994 on Copyright and Related Rights).

The provision of personal data is necessary for the registration process and the organisation of the conference. In the case of failure to provide data, it will not be possible to fulfil the aforementioned purpose.

**4. Period of storage of personal data**

We will store your personal data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the aforementioned purposes of processing.

**5. Recipients of the data**

Personal data of active participants of the Conference (i.e., first name and last name (and names of co-authors), affiliation, title of the paper, abstract) may be made public as part of the conference programme, on promotional materials related to the conference, as well as in all materials informing about the conference, including the conference website. Your personal data (image) may be made public through any media (local and nationwide), including websites administered by the University of Rzeszów, social media and in print. Your data may be transferred to external entities, such as travel agencies, insurers, and public

authorities or entities entitled to obtain data on the basis of applicable law, e.g., courts, law enforcement agencies or state institutions when they make a request based on an appropriate legal basis.

**6. Rights in relation to the processing of data**

You have the right to:

- a.access to your data and receive a copy of it;
- b. rectify (correct) your personal data;
- c. restrictions on the processing of personal data;
- d. deletion of personal data;
