



Agnieszka Elżbieta Demczuk, Post-doctoral degree, lawyer and political scientist, professor at the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin in the field of political and administration sciences, has been working at the Department of Political Systems and Human Rights at the Institute of Political Science and Public Administration since 2008; member of The Commission for Investigating Russian and Belarusian Influence on the Internal Security and Snterests of the Republic of Poland (pursuant to Order No. 55/2024 of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Poland); from 2020 head of the Propaganda and Disinformation Research Team at UMCS; in the years 2004-2008 coordinator of Polish Courtwatch Programme and TFF “Watch Docs. Human Rights in Film” in the Helsinki Foundation for Human Rights in Warsaw; author of works on the protection of human rights, freedom of expression, disinformation, the COVID-19-related infodemic and an information society; in 2022 participated in the work on the report “Counteracting disinformation in Poland. Systematic Recommendations”, prepared by forty Polish experts and containing over sixty recommendations, presented to the Senate of the Republic of Poland in 2023. In the years 2020-2023, participated in the Horizon 2020 research project entitled “Preserving fundamental rights in the use of digital technologies for e-health services” (REINITIALISE, No. 952357).
