



Grzegorz Bonusiak, Ph.D., associate professor - educated as an economist (AGH University of Science and Technology in Kraków) and sociologist (Higher School of Pedagogy in Rzeszów), received doctoral degree in the discipline of political science (University of Warsaw), and habilitation in the discipline of political science (KEN Pedagogical University in Kraków). He is currently employed as associate professor at the University of Rzeszów at the Institute of Political Science. His research interests cover two main areas. The first is ethnic groups and territories with special status in Europe, in particular cultural and regional autonomies in the Nordic countries. The second is the status of the world's indigenous peoples in inhabited states and in international space, with a special focus on ethnic groups living in areas of the northern Arctic Circle (Saami, Inuit, indigenous peoples of the Russian Federation). In recent years, his attention has been drawn to developments in migration policy and migrant integration in the Nordic countries.
