

Grzegorz Grzybek, Professor at the Institute of Pedagogical Science University of Rzeszow. He is an active researcher. From the first scientific article, which appeared in 2000, to the present day he has published one hundred and several dozen works, 23 book publications (including 11 authorial monographs). The strong aspects of his achievements and scientific activity should be considered primarily the creation of his own scientific theory - "development ethics". This theory has been associated with the University of Rzeszów through publications since then: Ethos of Life. Important elements from the latest publications concern such ideas as: ethical eroticism, erotic self-education, aesthetics of sexuality, human rights, including sexual rights. cooperation including the implementation of joint scientific projects: 1) Faculty of Culture and Art of the Adam Mickiewicz University in Lublin. I. Franki in Lviv: joint scientific projects were implemented; 2) Institute of Ethics and Bioethics of the University of Prešov. The cooperation resulted in scientific monographs. The results of the implementation were also published under his editorship in the Lviv-Rzeszow Scientific Journals.
