



Hillary Sedu is a lawyer of Nigerian origin. He is vice president of the Naples Bar Association, Italy. The first Afro-descendant elected councilor in a professional association in Italy. He is known for having sponsored several important cases of media relevance (example: murder of the mother of Donato Di Caprio, famous Italian TikToker, the Dissanayake case, an old lady - Sri Lankan - found covered of ants in a hospital in Naples, the case of Amin Abdelli, who lost his Italian citizenship due to the negligence of the public administration.
