



José Luis Hernández is a US and Mexican national born on 22 September 1982. He arrived in Poland in June 2022 as part of UNHCR's fast-track response to the Ukraine situation. Prior to working in Poland, José Luis was stationed with UNHCR in Mexico City, Mexico; Panama City, Panama; San José, Costa Rica; and San Salvador, El Salvador. He has also worked with UNICEF in South Sudan and with the United Nations Mission in South Sudan. Before joining the UN, José Luis worked with Human Rights Watch, a US-based human rights research and advocacy NGO, and with the Japan Exchange & Teaching Programme in rural Japan. His work experience includes responding to refugees' and children's protection needs in forced displacement and monitoring and reporting grave violations against children affected by armed conflict. He is currently a P3 professional with UNHCR. He received a master's degree in international law and human rights from New York University and a bachelor's degree in Microbiology and Chemistry from the University of Texas in El Paso. He speaks English, Spanish, and French.
