



Dr Karol Piękoś. Assistant Professor at the Institute of Political Science, University of Rzeszów. Member of the Polish Political Science Association since 2016 and secretary of the Rzeszów Branch of the Polish Association for European Studies since 2022. In 2018-2019, he conducted a research grant for young scientists entitled, The status of the political system of European dependent territories. Graduate of postgraduate studies in National Security and Crisis Management.
