Assistant professor of the Department of Military History of the Hetman Petro Sahaidachnyi National Ground Forces Academy in Lviv. Graduated from Uzhgorod State University, Faculty of Medicine in 1992. Education – higher medical. Education – doctor. In 2018 defended dissertation on the topic „Development of the Military Medical Service of the Armed Forces of Ukraine (1991-2015)”. The head of the office – a doctor of the Hetman Petro Sahaidachnyi National Ground Forces Academy polyclinic (2003-2018); teacher of the medical training course for non-commissioned officers of the Hetman Petro Sahaidachnyi National Ground Forces Academy (part-time, 2016), recipient of a scientific degree (2016-2018), teacher of the Department of Tactics of the Hetman Petro Sahaidachnyi National Ground Forces Academy in the discipline “History of Wars and Military Art” (2018-2022), associate professor of the Department of Military History of the Hetman Petro Sahaidachnyi National Ground Forces Academy (2022 – until now). The author of 45 scientific works, including articles in specialized scientific publications of Ukraine (1 – Scopus, Web of Science),

international publications. I have speeches at international conferences in Polish, 5 articles in Ukrainian and international monographs. Completed an international internship «Fundraising and Organization of Project Activities in Educational Establishments: European Experience». The courses were held by the Jagiellonian University in Krakow (2022). I am a co-author of the collective training manuals «Waging War in special conditions (historical examples)" and "Wars and Military Art of the beginning of the 21st century" .Supervised the scientific works of cadets «Weapons of mass destruction as a powerful military threat - historical excursion» and «Wars and armed conflicts in the post-Soviet space: experience for Ukraine». Head of the Society of Doctors of Polish Origin in Ukraine, which is a member of the World Federation of Polish Medical Organizations (registered in the USA). From August 2024 to December 2026, I am working on a research project of the I. Krypiakevych Institute of Ukrainian Studies of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine “Historical memory of Ukrainians in the conditions of war: from confrontation to consolidation”. The scientific project is implemented with the financial support of the National Research Fund of Ukraine (“Advanced Science in Ukraine” competition).
