



Monika Trojanowska-Strzęboszewska – Professor of Political Sciences at the Institute of Political Sciences and Administration of the Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University in Warsaw. She is the Head of European Studies Unit and the Head of the CSWU Interdisciplinary Migration Research Network. She is a Polish European Science Association and Polish European Community Studies Association member.

Her research interests include issues related to immigration and asylum policies in the EU, the functioning of the Schengen Area and the various aspects of internal security and human rights in Europe. She also focuses in her research on the civic and political integration of immigrants in their host countries in European countries.

She is the head of the research project financed by NCN called 'Participation in the public and political spheres of immigrants from Ukraine living in Poland - a preliminary study'. In 2020-2021, she took part in the research project 'Ukrainian Migrant Workers Opinions on their Stay in Poland during COVID-19 Lockdown' organised by the University of Szczecin in collaboration with the CSWU in Warsaw and the UAM in Poznań. She was also a full member of the research team at the EU Fifth Framework Program (titled 'The European Dilemma, Institutional Patterns and Politics of 'Racial' Discrimination').

On 14-18 October 2024, she was at a study visit in Brussels (EC, EP, Permanent Representation of Poland to the EU), organised in the frame of the project titled 'Three Seas Initiative Research Center' affiliated at the Institute of Political Studies of the Polish Academy of Sciences. She also completed research internships at the Institute for Minority Rights of the European Academy in Bolzano, Italy.

In recent years, she gave lectures at the following universities in Europe: University of Naples Federico II, Charles University in Prague, University of Vienna, and Pan-European University in Bratislava.
