



Dr hab. Patryk Pleskot, prof. UR– historian, political scientist, professor at the Rzeszów University, head of the Office of Historical Research at the Institute of National Remembrance (IPN) in Warsaw, graduate from Warsaw University and Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales in Paris. He was also studying at University of Nancy. Scholar of the Foundation of Polish Science, Ministry of National Education and the government of French Republic, visiting fellow at the University of Western Sydney. He did his research internships at the Hoover Institution (Stanford), Centre de Civilisation Polonaise (Paris Sorbonne), Centre of Migration Research (University of Warsaw), European Solidarity Centre (Gdańsk). He obtained his „habilitation” title at the Institute of Political Studies (Polish Academy of Sciences) in 2015. Area of his scientific interest consists of political, cultural and social history of communist Poland, Cold War, transitional justice, migration studies, intelligence and security studies. He is an author, co-author or editor of 50 books and more than 200 scientific articles.
