Member of research teams dealing with, m.in: sociological and psychological determinants of changes in the social consciousness of Poles during the systemic transformation, legitimization of the transformation of the political and economic system in Poland, ownership transformations, including privatization, methodology of social research and public opinion. Author of numerous scientific articles, analyses, expert opinions and papers commissioned by public and private sector institutions. Member of the Scientific Council of the Disciplines of Political Science and Administration and Security Studies at the University of Warsaw.
