

Wojciech J. Kosior, Ph.D., LL.M. – public prosecutor, currently Deputy District Prosecutor for the city of Rzeszów, also acting as Coordinator for Combating Crimes Committed out of Hate. Academic employee of the Institute of Legal Sciences at the University of Rzeszów. Author of several dozen scientific publications and participant of many national and international scientific conferences.
