

Zbigniew Czachór - Ph.D., Professor of Political Sciences and lawyer at the Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznań and professor at the Jacob of Paradies University, Gorzów Wielkopolski, specialising in the European Union law, public international law and international/European political relations. Head of the Department of European Integration Research at the Faculty of Political Sciences and Journalism of Adam Mickiewicz University. A long-time advisor at the Office of the Committee for European Integration and in the Sejm and Senate. Chairman of the Program Council of the Center for European Research and Education. President of the board of the Polish Association for European Studies. His research interests focus on broadly understood issues of European integration and changes taking place in the European Union. Prof. Zbigniew Czachór is the author of many scientific articles, published in Poland and abroad. The subject of his first monograph (the doctoral dissertation) was the system of European Political Cooperation, recognized as the first institutionalized form of joint coordination of foreign policy among the member states of the European Communities. This work was a combination of both the theoretical approach to European integration and its practice in the sphere of international (global) political relations. The habilitation thesis was devoted to the changes and developments taking place in the European Union system after the Maastricht Treaty on European Union, and the professor's book concerned the subject of crises in the European Union.
