## DAY I (November 16):

Gathering of the participants, checking the attendance lists (around 7:30 am).

Departure from the meeting point, transfer to Wieliczka - visiting the historic Salt Mine (along the tourist route for approx. 3 hours) - an extraordinary place, hidden from the world, full of secrets and legends. A place where the history of the Earth is constantly intertwined with the history of mankind. It is also a priceless monument of nature and technology, established in 1978, as one of the first twelve places and objects in the world, under the UNESCO World Heritage List.

In the afternoon, transfer to Krakow - a walk around the city with a licensed English-speaking guide, including Barbican, Florian's Gate, Cloth Hall, St. Mary's Church, Market Square Underground, Tadeusz Kościuszko's oath plaque, Prussian Homage plaque, Cathedral: Royal Tombs, Sigismund's Bell, Wawel Dragon.

Transfer to the hotel, check-in.

Free time in the evening.

Dinner (approx. 6:00 pm)

## DAY II (November 17):

Breakfast (8:00 am)

Check-out (9:00 am) and transfer to Auschwitz.

Visiting the Auschwitz-Birkenau Museum (tour around 3.5h - 4h). Time at the disposal of participants.

Arrival at the meeting point in the evening - approx. 8:30 pm.
